FRLs offer support, advice, and information to all foster, kinship, and pre-adoptive parents. FRLs help organize and lead our main Kid's Net training opportunities and support groups.

There are Family Resource Liaisons for each DCF Area Office and Adoption Development & Licensing Units (ADLUs) to assist with supporting your caregiving experience with local knowledge and resources. FRLs are uniquely positioned to assist Departmental caregivers by offering advice and experience in navigating the child welfare, education, health care, and other systems.
